MANZANAR PILGRIMAGE BUS INSTRUCTIONS 2023

Thank you for your interest in attending the 54th Annual Manzanar Pilgrimage, Saturday April 29, 2023.

Departure: **7:00 a.m. sharp**

950 E. 3rd Street Los Angeles, CA 90013
(Garage of Aliso Apartments)

Please arrive 30 minutes early for check-in and boarding.



Parking: Free gated garage parking is available at the departure site. Please pull a parking ticket when entering the garage. The Bus Monitor will give you a free validation card to use when exiting at night. When leaving the garage at night, just use the parking ticket you pulled in the morning along with the validation card to exit free of charge. If you are being dropped off, the bus will load from the driveway so you can be dropped off next to the driveway..

The Bus: The bus is air-conditioned and equipped with restroom facilities. A 15-minute rest stop will be made halfway in Mojave. There is room in the storage compartment for ice chests, lawn chairs and umbrellas. The bus will arrive at the site just before the 12 noon program. At 3:30 p.m. the bus will take participants to the Interpretive Center at the site. The bus will leave to return to Los Angeles at 4:30 p.m, arriving in L.A. about 8:30 p.m..

At the site: The Manzanar National Historic Site is located 5 miles from the nearest town and does not have food facilities. While we encourage you to bring enough food and drink you will need for the day, there is a fast-food restaurant in Mojave. If you pre-ordered a bento, you will receive a ticket on the bus for your chicken teriyaki or vegetarian bento. **If you now wish to order a bento, email jafujii@manzanarcommittee.org as soon as possible**

The weather can be unpredictable, but generally can be hot and windy at this time of the year. We suggest layers of clothing, a hat, sunscreen and **to drink plenty of water while at the site.**
Please bring a refillable water bottle that you can refill at the site.

The ground can be uneven and sandy in places, so closed-toe shoes are recommended when exploring the site. More information about the site is available at www.nps.gov/manz
